



# Spanish for Kids

**Who:** Beach Elementary students entering K – 5<sup>th</sup> grade in Fall 2011

**What:** **Spanish language classes lead by experienced teachers** — Students will learn vocabulary related to a variety of everyday themes, practice using it within sentences, and master many useful phrases. Program uses a full-immersion approach, and students learn while singing songs, playing games, and doing hands-on projects. Continuing students will be grouped by proficiency and learn vocabulary from new subject areas that encourages them to build upon previous knowledge.
