



Spanish Summer Programs 2010

The Spanish Immersion Summer Programs are designed to give children a unique opportunity to learn or improve their Spanish language skills. We offer week-long summer camps as well as daily classes. In both programs students are grouped according to both age and language proficiency to ensure maximum learning for each individual.

Summer Camps

The camps consist of nine one-week sessions. During each week, students participate in interactive games, music and movement activities, and art projects that center around a specific theme. Beginner students will learn basic language skills to supplement the vocabulary linked to each theme. More advanced students will learn useful phrases, grammatical concepts and practice their conversation skills. Each week culminates with a sing-along and presentation, where the kids get to show off what they learned. Sessions run Monday–Friday. Min 4 / Max 16 students per session. Ages 4+. Students may sign up for any number of sessions.
