



Spanish Summer Programs 2011

The Spanish Immersion Summer Programs are designed to give children a unique opportunity to learn or improve their Spanish language skills. We offer week-long summer camps as well as daily classes. In both programs students are grouped according to both age and language proficiency to ensure maximum learning for each individual.

Summer Camps

The camps consist of six one-week sessions. During each week, students participate in interactive games, music and movement activities, and arts & crafts projects that center around a specific theme. Beginner students learn basic language skills to supplement the vocabulary linked to each theme. More advanced students learn useful phrases, grammatical concepts and practice their conversation skills. Each week culminates with a sing-along and presentation, where the kids get to show off what they learned. Sessions run Monday–Friday. Min 6 / Max 16 students per session. Ages 4+. Students may sign up for any number of sessions.

* *Mysterious Water Wonders*



Take a deep breath and come with us on a voyage to discover the mysterious wonders of the deep blue sea. Together we'll learn the Spanish vocabulary related to marine life, fish, seashells, and more! We'll build a waterwheel, extract salt from sea water and learn the science of cleaning and reusing dirty water. From water balloon games to ice painting to delicious icy "raspados", it is all part of water fun!

* *Bugs' Life*



Is your little scientist fascinated with bugs and nature? Our young explorers will grab their magnifying lenses, nets and terrariums and head outside to collect some "bichos". We'll make insect dough creations, egg carton caterpillars, marble-rolling slug trails, ants-on-a-log snacks, and play lots of games about bugs and nature—all in español!

* *Pirates of the "Caribe"*



Yo-Ho-Ho. It's a pirate's life for us! Anchors Aweigh – come join us as we sail the seas and get marooned on Viva el Español's Treasure Island. We'll follow the clues in search of lost treasures and play tricks on the friendly Spanish-speaking pirate before he makes us walk the plank!
